Section 4.1 of the University Endowment Lands Official Community Plan and the following bylaws establish the rules of eligibility of a candidate for a Council Membership vacancy on the Community Advisory Council (or CAC).

Bylaw 5 Election of Council Members

- (1) The Council shall have seven elected Council Members who must be Electors and shall represent the four Neighbourhoods in accordance with subsection (5).
- (2) Each Council Member shall own property or reside in the Neighbourhood represented by that Council Member.
- (3) Subject to the Initial Special Election, the Council Members shall be elected at Council Elections.
- (4) All Electors shall be eligible to stand for election to be a Council Member to represent the Neighbourhood in which they reside or own property and shall also be eligible to vote in such election.
- (5) The Council Members shall represent the four Neighbourhoods as follows:
 - (a) two Council Members shall represent Area A;
 - (b) one Council Member shall represent Area B;
 - (c) one Council Member shall represent Area C; and
 - (d) three Council Members shall represent Area D.
- (6) Subject to subsection (2) of bylaw 4, and subject to bylaws 7 and 8, each Council Member shall serve a term of three years, or until the next Council Election, whichever comes first.
- (7) The Council Members will be volunteers.
- (8) Council membership is not transferable.

Elector

An *Elector* is a person who meets **ALL** the following qualifications:

- Is 18 years of age or older or will be on the voting day;
 - Is a Canadian citizen (Note that Landed Immigrants who are not Canadian citizens do not qualify as an *Elector*);
 - Has been a resident of British Columbia, as determined in accordance with Section 52 of the *Local Government Act*, for six months immediately preceding voting day;
 - Has lived or owned land in the UEL for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; and
 - Has not been disqualified by law from voting.
